- 3. What country is Philippi located in? At the time of the letter, Philippi was a colony of which super-power?
- 4. During which missionary journey did Paul first visit Philippi?
- 5. On whose authority is Paul and Timothy writing this letter? Is this important?
- 6. What does the word 'saint' mean, and why is it important that Paul addresses his congregation this way?
- 7. What was the occasion that prompted this letter & where did Paul send it from?
